MEDICATIONS IN SCHOOL

According to New York State Law, the only way medication can be given during school hours is if the school receives a note from a **physician** stating:

1. Name of medication and dosage.
2. Time to be given.
3. A request that it be dispensed in school.

Also required is **a note from the parent** giving the school permission to give the medication.

Please use this signed form for all over-the-counter and/or prescription medication that your child may need to use during school. This includes antibiotics, aspirin, Tylenol, cold medications etc.

DO NOT have medications in school for a student to take on his/her own. We have many students who are allergic to certain drugs. If any of these drugs should unknowingly fall into their hands, the results could be fatal.
